Essay Guidelines & Structure

Essay Length: 1,200–1,500 words

Format: Typed, double-spaced, 12-point font (Times New Roman or similar)

Your essay should be written in **three clearly defined sections**. You may use headings if you choose, but it is not required.

Section 1: Personal Testimony (Foundation)

In this section, share your faith journey.

Address the following:

- When and how did you come to know Jesus Christ personally?
- What has your relationship with Christ taught you about yourself?
- Describe a specific moment, challenge, or experience where your faith shaped your actions, decisions, or perspective.
- How has your relationship with Jesus influenced your character, values, or daily life?

This section should reflect honesty, growth, and authenticity.

Section 2: Understanding God's Plan for Your Future

In this section, reflect on where you believe God is leading you next.

Address the following:

- What do you believe God is calling you to in the near future (education, career, service, family, ministry, or personal growth)?

- How do you seek God’s guidance when making decisions?
- What gifts, talents, or passions do you believe God has placed inside you, and how do they connect to your future plans?

You do not need to have everything figured out—clarity, faith, and intention matter more than certainty.

Section 3: Glorifying God Through Your Life Choices

In this section, explain how you plan to live out your faith moving forward.

Address the following:

- How do you intend to honor and glorify God in your daily life?
- What values will guide your decisions as you move into adulthood?
- How do you hope your life will reflect Christ to others?

This section should demonstrate purpose, responsibility, and commitment to living a Christ-centered life.

Important Notes

- **Do not include your name or any identifying information** in your essay.
- Essays should be original and written entirely by the student.
- Scripture references are welcome but not required.
- Grammar, organization, and clarity will be considered, but content and sincerity are most important.

Final Reminder

This essay is not about being perfect—it’s about being **faithful, reflective, and intentional**. Share your story with honesty and confidence, knowing that your testimony matters.
